In Hebrew pronouns, verbs, adjectives, and several other word types are categorized and gender specific, but since you're doing so well, I won't be using colour codes anymore. I trust that you will be able to see for yourself if the gender of the word is male or female.


In our 30_ series, we will be having a theme for every lesson with fun exercises to help you practice what you have learnt and heard in the online lesson. Our theme for this week is:

The word בְּיֹתְה has different meanings. It can mean class, classroom or grade.

There are different grades in school in Israel, just as in other countries, but they are not called first grade, second grade, third grade, and so on. They rather use the letters of the alphabet.


